

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Changing 12% Distribution Request)**

RESOLUTION NO. 05-064

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Arizona Revised Statute 41-1505, which provides for the establishment**
2 **of a Local Communities Fund (LCF) administered by the Arizona Department of**
3 **Commerce to provide grants to cities, towns and counties as defined in title 11,**
4 **Arizona Revised Statutes, for government services that benefit the general public,**
5 **including public safety, mitigation of impacts of gaming, or promotion of commerce**
6 **and economic development; and**

7 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 04-562 entitled Approving Second Disbursement of the**
8 **Gaming Compact Section 12(d) 12% contribution, Tohono O'odham deposited its 12%**
9 **funds in the LCF and approved \$65,000 to City of Tucson for Vista Del Rio**
10 **Neighborhood Association to assist with expansion and educational Programs at**
11 **Archeology Park and approved \$30,000 to the City of Tucson for underwriting of a fire**
12 **safety trailer for children to learn about fire safety; and**

13 **WHEREAS, since Resolution No. 04-562 was approved Vista Del Rio Neighborhood Association**
14 **and City of Tucson Fire revised their initial request, thereby requesting a change to**
15 **their disbursement. Vista Del Rio Neighborhood completed their park expansion and**
16 **is requesting the \$65,000 be used for educational programs only and City of Tucson**
17 **purchased its fire safety trailer and is requesting that in lieu of the trailer, the funds**
18 **be used to convert a 1970's vintage American La France fire engine into an interactive**
19 **fire and life safety tool for use at schools and safety fairs; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the proposed changes were presented to the Commerce Committee for consideration**
21 **at a meeting held on February 3, 2005.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
23 **approves changes to Resolution No. 04-562 distribution of 12% funds in the following**
24 **manner:**


25 **\$65,000 City of Tucson for Vista Del Rio Neighborhood Association to assist with**
26 **educational programs at Archeology park.**


27 **\$30,000 City of Tucson for City of Tucson to covert a 1970's vintage American La France**
28 **fire engine into an interactive fire and life safety tool for use at schools and safety**
29 **fairs.**

1 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that notification to the Arizona Department of Commerce, Commerce
2 and Economic Development Commission will be made by the Executive Office
3 regarding aforementioned changes.


4 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH Day

6 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 170.3[03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
7 Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
8 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
9 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
10 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
