9		River, and Yavapai Apache tribes respectively; and
10	WHEREAS,	at a meeting of Arizona Tribal Leaders on April 4, 2003, a majority of the Arizona
11		Indian Gaming Association membership agreed that each tribe would contribute an
12		additional 0.27%, for a total Proposition 202 campaign of 2.77% for each tribe
13		respectively, so that the final, total campaign cost would be shared in a
14		proportionately equitable manner; and
15	WHEREAS,	on September 16, 2004, the Legislative Council did adopt Resolution No. 04-461
16		Authorizing the Use of Arizona Magic Wide Area Progressive System Contributions
17		Fund in the amount of \$168,678.57; and
18	WHEREAS,	Legislative Council Resolution No. 04-461 further resolved that payment for the
19		balance in the amount of \$104,951.43 be considered by the Legislative Council at a
20		time when the FY-05 tribal budgets have been determined; and
21	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council did consider and approve the tribal budgets on or about
22		December 1, 2004; and
23	WHEREAS,	the authorizations provided in Legislative Council Resolution No. 04-461 have been
24		accomplished and there still remains an outstanding balance in the amount of
25		\$104,951.43.
26	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
27		authorizes the use of the Nation's FY 2005 General Revenue Surplus Funds in the
28		amount of \$104,951.43 to be paid and applied towards the Nation's outstanding loan
