

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Creation of a Dedicated Revenue Account for the Deposit of Funds
Received by the Tohono O'odham Nation's Department of Information and Technology)

RESOLUTION NO. 05-081

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Council Resolution No. 97-082, the Department of Information**
2 **and Technology ("DOIT") was created and established under the General Support**
3 **Services also known as the Administrative Support Offices, to assist Executive Branch**
4 **departments with Management Information System requirements; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Department of Information and Technology in consideration of its fiscal**
6 **responsibility to the tribal government has a stated objective to "seek funding from**
7 **outside sources to enhance its ability to meet its goal and reduce the Nation's**
8 **financial commitment for its salaries and operation."**

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

- 10 **1. That the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the Department of**
11 **Information and Technology to establish a dedicated revenue account in which**
12 **all funds obtained by the Program from outside sources other than the Nation**
13 **shall be deposited;**
- 14 **2. The Department of Information and Technology shall provide a quarterly report**
15 **to the Budget and Finance of the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council and**
16 **an annual report shall be made to the General Council to include clients and**
17 **revenue;**
- 18 **3. That the Tohono O'odham Nation's Official, to wit: once revenues are available**
19 **the Treasurer is hereby authorized to open a revenue account;**
- 20 **4. The Department of Information and Technology will expend funds in this**
21 **dedicated revenue account for operational purposes consistent with budget**
22 **approved by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH, Day**
24 **of FEBRUARY, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,775.3 FOR; 465.6**
25 **AGAINST; 222.5 NOT VOTING; and 166.3 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
26 **by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by**
27 **the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
28 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
29 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


