

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Establishing and Approving the Tohono O'odham Nation Youth Council
Fiscal Year 2005 Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 05-094

- 1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Youth Council was established by Tohono O'odham**
2 **Legislative Council Resolution No. 95-216 for the purpose of serving as the official**
3 **voice of the Tohono O'odham Youth and administratively placed under the direct**
4 **supervision of the Department of Education Tohono O'odham Youth Services; and**
- 5 **WHEREAS, upon the initial assessment of the Nation's programs in 2003 the Chairwoman of the**
6 **Nation directed the rejuvenation of the Nation's Youth Council and through the**
7 **Administrative Plan 2004 has outlined a plan to assign one staff member to**
8 **leadership development; and**
- 9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Youth Council has evolved over the past twenty years**
10 **without an annual budget solely for its own purpose and functions; and**
- 11 **WHEREAS, it has been determined that in order for the Tohono O'odham Nation Youth Council**
12 **to serve as youth leaders from their respective Districts, it is necessary to strengthen**
13 **their administrative functions and provide an established financial base; and**
- 14 **WHEREAS, the Nation's Youth Council produced and approved on January 14, 2005 a FY 2005**
15 **budget in a total amount of \$132,000.00 in accordance with the budget attached**
16 **hereto and presented, along with the Tohono O'odham Youth Services and the**
17 **Executive Office, to their oversight committee, HRDC, and the Budget & Finance**
18 **Committee of which they received their approval; and**
- 19 **WHEREAS, the Chairwoman of the Nation has produced a list of priorities for one-time spending**
20 **from FY-05 surplus funding and has included in this priority list an FY-05 budget for**
21 **the Tohono O'odham Nation Youth Council.**
- 22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
23 **establishes and approves the FY-2005 Youth Council Budget as one time funding from**
24 **the general fund FY-05 surplus.**
- 25 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any unspent funding from the approved FY 2005 budget shall be**
26 **carry-over for FY-06 as the Tohono O'odham Nation Youth Council budget.**
- 27 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council Resolution No. 95-216 is affirmed in that**
28 **the Youth serving on the Tohono O'odham Nation Youth Council are official**
29 **representatives of the Nation's youth and is formally established with all references**
30 **made therein**

1 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Youth Council shall present to the
2 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council their By-Laws for approval and adoption during
3 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council March 2005 General Session.

4 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH Day
5 of FEBRUARY, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,270.8 FOR; 358.9
6 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
7 Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
8 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
9 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
10 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


