1	WHEREAS,	on February 16,2005, the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI) broadcast an American Congress of Congress
2		urgent action request asking tribes to submit letters to their senators opposing the
3		nomination of William G. Myers III for confirmation to a lifetime seat on the United
4		States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit; and
5	WHEREAS,	the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals is the federal appellate court for the Tohono
6		O'odham Nation and the Tohono O'odham has a direct interest in the judges
7		appointed to the Ninth Circuit; and
8	WHEREAS,	research was conducted into Mr. Myers' history that revealed that on numerous
9		occasions Mr. Myers has misconstrued the clear intent of the law to achieve
10		ideological objectives, which has resulted in criticism from federal courts reviewing
11		Mr. Myers' opinions; and
12	WHEREAS,	while he was the Department of the Interior Solicitor, despite the well documented
13		government-to-government relationship, Mr. Myers failed to consult with tribes on
14		issues regarding mining permits on sacred lands, despite repeated contacts with the
15		companies seeking the permits; and
16	WHEREAS,	Mr. Myers' actions and legal opinions related to issuing mining permits are especially
17		troubling since Mr. Myers was a former lobbyist for the mining industry; and
18	WHEREAS,	$Mr. Myers' \ misconception \ of the \ law \ and \ actions \ in \ direct \ conflict \ with \ regulation \ and$
19		policy call into question Mr. Myers' ethics and ability to be neutral fact finder, both
20		of which are indispensable traits for one escalated to the status of federal judge; and
21	WHEREAS,	if confirmed, Mr. Myers' personal opinions are likely to lead him to issue detrimental
22		decisions that lack solid legal foundation on Indian related matters.
23	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does hereby
24		oppose the nomination and confirmation of William G. Myers III as Judge for the
25		Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals or any federal judgeship.
26	BE IT FURT	HER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation supports the National Congress of
27		American Indian's continued opposition to Mr. Myers' nomination, as expressed in
28		NCAI resolution # ABQ-03-061.

5	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council urges the Arizona
6	Delegation to oppose William G. Myers III for confirmation to a lifetime seat on the
7	United States Court of Appeals for the Ninth Circuit.
