**RESOLUTION NO. 05-122**

1 **WHEREAS, the HICKIWAN District Council held a regular district meeting on January 12, 2005 to**  
2 **discuss the extension and amendment of the El Paso Pipeline budgets from the seven**  
3 **communities; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the HICKIWAN District received \$94,757.44 from their share of the El Paso Pipeline**  
5 **budget between the Sif Oidak District; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the HICKIWAN District Council has distributed equally in the amount of \$13,536.77 to**  
7 **each community; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the community of Ventana is including new line items #31-7082-710, 810, 850, 865 &**  
9 **866; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the seven (7) communities requests for an extension of the El Paso Pipeline Budget**  
11 **from December 01, 2004 - September 30, 2005; and**


12 **WHEREAS, the HICKIWAN District by #HD11205-03 approved the El Paso Gas Pipeline Budget**

15 **the budget amendment and extension from December 01, 2004 - September 30, 2005.**

16 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the amendment include the aforementioned line items to the**  
17 **Ventana community budget.**

18 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
19 **of MARCH, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,774.7 FOR; -0-**  
20 **AGAINST; 855.0 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
21 **Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
22 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
23 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
24 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
