

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the U.S. Department of Justice 2003 State Homeland Security Grant Program)

RESOLUTION NO. 05-126

1 **WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice has distributed grants to counties, through**
2 **their respective states, to fund equipment purchases by departments that provide**
3 **public safety services within their respective jurisdictions; and**

4 **WHEREAS, Indian tribes have been designated to receive funds through the counties, requiring**
5 **tribes to enter into Intergovernmental Agreements with counties; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has negotiated an Intergovernmental Agreement with**
7 **Pima County for \$19,734.00 on a reimbursement basis to finance equipment**
8 **purchases by the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Public Safety for a specific**
9 **list of equipment designated by the Intergovernmental Agreement and requests a**
10 **Waiver of Indirect Costs associated with administering this grant; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the authorized equipment purchases categories are Personal Protective Equipment**
12 **(PPE), Detection Equipment, Decontamination Equipment, and General Support**
13 **Equipment; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Agreement has been reviewed and approved by the Office of the Attorney General,**
15 **Executive Committee, Domestic Affairs Committee, Budget & Finance Committee, and**
16 **therefore said committees recommend approval by the Legislative Council.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
18 **above-mentioned Intergovernmental Agreement with Pima County for \$19,734.00 on**
19 **a reimbursement basis for the purchase of equipment under the United States**
20 **Department of Justice 2003 State Homeland Security Grant Program and approves a**
21 **Waiver of Indirect Cost to administer this grant.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Public Safety is**
23 **authorized to expend funds from this grant in the amount of \$19,734.00 beginning**
24 **April 1, 2003 through April 30, 2005.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH, Day**
26 **of MARCH, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0-**
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
29 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
30 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
31 **Stat. 984).**


