

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(BIA/Tribal Budget System Priority ranking for FY 2007)**

RESOLUTION NO. 05-145

1 **WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs Papago Agency has requested that the Tohono O'odham**
2 **Legislative Council identify funding priorities for the projected FY 2007 Planning**
3 **Base amounts under the Tribal Priority Allocations of the Bureau Budget for FY 2007;**
4 **and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Papago Agency submitted to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council and the**
6 **Executive Office the 2007 President's Budget Request and related Priority**
7 **Justification for the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA); and**

8 **WHEREAS, the BIA has provided blank forms entitled "Justification for Proposed Changes Based**
9 **on the 2005 Program" and requested that the tribe provide justification for their**
10 **programs, including program accomplishments and identification of targets for**
11 **each program; and**

12 **WHEREAS, through establishing tribal priorities and providing justification, the Tohono**
13 **O'odham Nation (Nation) can identify to the BIA those areas which are priorities to**
14 **the Nation and for which the Nation requests the BIA to secure sufficient or**
15 **additional resources available under the Tribal Priority Allocation budget category;**
16 **and**

17 **WHEREAS, the rankings depict the Nation's priorities as previously established; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Executive Office has prepared and the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has**
19 **reviewed the proposed FY 2007 Budgets and justifications for P.L. 93-638 contracted**
20 **programs and Priority Ranking Numbers as submitted by the Executive Office.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the**
22 **Projected Planning Base Amounts and Rankings under Budgets B and C of the**
23 **Bureau budget be adopted for FY 2007.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the following Top Six**
25 **(6) Priority Ranking be adopted for FY 2007 for the P.L. 93-638 contracted programs:**

- 26 **1. Roads Maintenance**
- 27 **2. Human Services**
- 28 **3. Law Enforcement**
- 29 **4. Education**
- 30 **5. Tribal Courts**
- 31 **6. Natural Resources**
