(Approving Department of Human Services, Division of Family Assistance - FY06 Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program - Budget and Proposal, Account No. 12-1310)

RESOLUTION NO. 05-155

1 **WHEREAS, the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) has been beneficial in**
2 **providing financial assistance to eligible low-income households in meeting utility**
3 **needs, i.e., electricity, propane, water and wood; and**

4 **WHEREAS, funds have been made available to the Tohono O'odham Nation for FY2006 through**
5 **the State of Arizona, Department of Economic Security, Community Services**
6 **Administration; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does meet the requirements to operate a Low Income**
8 **Home Energy Assistance Program; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is hereby submitting its application for FY2006 funding**
10 **through the State of Arizona, Department of Economic Security, Community Services**
11 **Administration in the amount of \$53,980.00 for contract period July 01, 2005 through**
12 **June 30, 2006; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services, Family Assistance Division, Low**
14 **Income Home Energy Assistance Program has submitted the FY06 Low Income Home**
15 **Energy Assistance Service Methodology and budget in the amount of \$53,980.00 for**
16 **review and approval.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:**

18 **1. It hereby approves and authorizes the proposed FY2006 Low Income Home Energy**
19 **Assistance Program (LIHEAP) budget in the amount of \$53,980.00 and authorizes**
20 **expenditures in accordance with the attached budget.**

21 **2. The Tohono O'odham Nation's official to wit: The Chairwoman is hereby**
22 **authorized to negotiate and execute the contract.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05TH Day**
24 **of APRIL, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
25 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of**
26 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
27 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
28 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
