12	WHEREAS,	the proposed Tank Site is a 100' x 100' square parcel encompassing 0.23 acres more
13		or less; and
14	WHEREAS,	the proposed Water Storage Tank will be 20 feet in diameter, 15 feet in height with a
15		33,000 gallon capacity; and
16	WHEREAS,	TOUA has respectfully submitted all documents and pertinent information (attached
17		hereto and incorporated herein by reference) for uses consistent with the authorized
18		purposes of TOUA; and
19	WHEREAS,	the TOUA Vamori Water Storage Tank Site Right-of-Way and related facilities will be
20		of substantial benefit to the Vamori Community, Chukut Kuk District, Tohono
21		O'odham Nation and their respective members; and
22	WHEREAS,	the Chukut Kuk District Council approved the requested Right-of-Way with its
23		Resolution No. 2005-04 enacted on March 12, 2005; and
24	WHEREAS,	the Natural Resources Committee reviewed the Right-of-Way on March 21, 2005 and
25		by consensus recommends approval thereof by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
