17	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Utility Authority, if it determines in the future that the well can
18		no longer be used as a water supply well, will cause it to be remediated, or if that is
19		economically unfeasible, will cause it to be plugged and abandoned according to the
20		Tohono O'odham Nation's accepted standards; and
21	WHEREAS,	the Water Resources Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
22		recommends approval of transferring the exclusive right to control, maintain and
23		operate the well known as B4 to the Tohono O'odham Utility Authority.
24	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby grants
25		exclusive rights to control, maintain and operate the well known as B4 to the Tohono
26		O'odham Utility Authority for so long as the well shall provide water sufficient in
27		quality and quantity for use as a domestic supply well for Kukatch Community.
