

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance of USDOJ-COPS Office TRGP Equipment Grant Award No. 2004HEWX0008
in the amount of \$609,363.20 for the TON Police Department)

RESOLUTION NO. 05-175

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department (TOPD) applied for and was awarded**
2 **a grant under the Department of Justice Community Oriented Policing Services-**
3 **Tribal Resource Grant Program for funding of needed equipment and technology;**
4 **and**

5 **WHEREAS, the award amount of \$609,363.20 under Grant No. 2004HEWX0008 is to be used**
6 **specifically for the acquisition of needed equipment, technology upgrade and**
7 **vehicles; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the grant term is from September 1, 2004 thru August 30, 2005; and**

9 **WHEREAS, a matching contribution of 10% or \$67,704.80 is required from TONPD and these**
10 **funds have been identified under the Executive Surplus Revenue-General Fund; and**

11 **WHEREAS, due to the grant conditions imposed by DOJ COPS Office on their awards, Indirect**
12 **Costs are considered unallowable; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department requests the Tohono O'odham**
14 **Legislative Council to approve the acceptance of this grant award and budget in the**
15 **amount of \$609,363.20; and**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that it**
17 **hereby accepts and authorizes the implementation and expenditure of the DOJ COPS**
18 **Grant Award No. 2004HEWX0008 and COPS-TRGP Budget in the amount of**
19 **\$609,363.20, and waives the indirect cost as unallowable due to the grant conditions**
20 **of this grant.**

21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Officials to wit, the Chairwoman is**
22 **hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any**
23 **amendments affecting the funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for**
24 **further prior approval by this Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH, Day**
26 **of APRIL, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
27 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of**
28 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
29 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
30 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
