(Acceptance and Authorization for Budget Amendment #1 in the amount of \$67,704.80 of Executive Surplus Revenue to be allocated to TONPD for the Required 10% Tribal Match for DOJ COPS TRGP Grant #2004HEWX0008)

RESOLUTION NO. 05-176

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department (TONPD) has successfully applied for**
2 **and has been awarded a grant from the Department of Justice - Community Oriented**
3 **Policing Services-Tribal Resource Grant Program (DOJ COPS-TRGP) for funding of**
4 **needed equipment and technology; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the award is to be used for the acquisition of needed equipment, technology upgrade**
6 **and vehicles, and requires a matching contribution of 10% or \$67,704.80 from the**
7 **TONPD; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Executive Office has identified these funds from the Executive Surplus Funds-**
9 **General Fund and are to be allocated to TONPD for the required match and noted as**
10 **a one-time funding to the base budget for TONPD; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the TONPD requests the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council to approve the one-time**
12 **funding to be allocated from the Executive Surplus Funds-General Fund under**
13 **Budget Amendment #1 for the matching contribution to the COPS TRGP Grant; and**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that it**
15 **hereby accepts and authorizes the allocation of the Executive Surplus Funds as a one-**
16 **time funding to the TONPD base budget for the purposes of meeting the required**
17 **match.**

18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that it also hereby**
19 **accepts and authorizes the implementation and expenditure of Budget Amendment**
20 **#1 of the TON Police Department for the matching contribution of 10% or \$67,704.80**
21 **under the DOJ COPS-TRGP Grant #2004HEWX0008.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH Day**
23 **of APRIL, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,164.1 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
24 **465.6 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (¶)**
25 **of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
26 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
27 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
