

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving Amendment No. 1 to Attorney Contract with Gilmore & Turner, P.L.L.C.)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 05-189**

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Council Resolution No. 04-550, the Tohono O'odham Nation**  
2 **(the "Nation") entered into an Attorney Contract with Gilmore & Turner, P.L.L.C. (the**  
3 **"Attorneys") for the purpose of providing legal representation to the Nation in cases**  
4 **arising in Pima County, Arizona under the Indian Child Welfare Act which concern**  
5 **the Nation's interests ; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract is in the amount of \$25,000 for the period from October 1, 2004**  
7 **to September 30, 2005; and**

8 **WHEREAS, additional funding is required to continue representation of the Nation by the**  
9 **Attorneys under the Attorney Contract; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Attorney General has proposed Amendment No. 1 to the Attorney Contract which**  
11 **increases the Contract amount from \$25,000 to \$45,000; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the budget of the Office of Attorney General (01-1031-810) has sufficient funds for the**  
13 **increased Contract amount; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget & Finance Committees recommend approval by the**  
15 **Legislative Council of Amendment No. 1 to the Attorney Contract.**

16 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 17 **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves Amendment No. 1 to the**  
18 **Attorney Contract, in the form attached hereto, which increases the Contract**  
19 **amount to \$45,000.**
- 20 **2. Funding for Amendment No. 1 shall be provided from the budget of the Office of**  
21 **Attorney General (01-1031-810).**
- 22 **3. The Chairwoman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute Amendment**  
23 **No. 1.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
25 **of APRIL, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
26 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) of**  
27 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**  
28 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
29 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
