8	WHEREAS,	additional funding is required to continue representation of the Nation by the				
9		Attorneys under the Attorney Contract; and				
10	WHEREAS,	the Attorney  General  has  proposed  Amendment  No.  1  to  the  Attorney  Contract  which				
11		increases the Contract amount from \$25,000 to \$45,000; and				
12	WHEREAS,	the budget of the Office of Attorney General (01-1031-810) has sufficient funds for the				
13		increased Contract amount; and				
14	WHEREAS,	the  Domestic  Affairs  and  Budget  &  Finance  Committees  recommend  approval  by  the  description  approval  by  the  description  d
