

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving Tohono O'odham Planning & Economic Development Department -  
Planning Administration FY-2005 Budget Modification/Amendment No. 1)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 05-194**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Planning Administration continues to meet the needs**  
2 **of the Tohono O'odham; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the continued operation of the Planning Administration is essential to continue to**  
4 **provide the Tohono O'odham Nation with the technical assistance requested from the**  
5 **Tribal entities and Districts within the exterior boundaries of the Tohono O'odham**  
6 **Nation; and**

7 **WHEREAS, surplus dollars for Fiscal Year 2004 have been identified as accessible; and**

8 **WHEREAS, \$112,000, non-recurring funding, will be allocated to the Tohono O'odham Planning**  
9 **Administration budget for Fiscal Year 2005 to acquire professional services for a**  
10 **Public Works Feasibility Study and to hire Grant writers; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Planning and Economic Development Department's Planning**  
12 **Administration Fiscal Year 2005 Budget Amendment No. 1 has been approved by the**  
13 **Office of the Chairwoman.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**  
15 **approves the attached budget for the Planning and Economic Development**  
16 **Department's Planning Administration Fiscal Year 2005 Budget Modification/**  
17 **Amendment No. 1 in the amount of \$112,000.00.**

18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the surplus funding amount of \$112,000.00 is available on a**  
19 **one-time basis and will not carry over to FY-06 Planning Administration base budget.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
21 **of APRIL, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
22 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2)**  
23 **& (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
24 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
25 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
26 **Stat. 984).**
