

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Enrollment FY 2005 Enrollment Program Budget Amendment #1
from the FY 2005 General Revenue in the amount of \$40,000.00)

RESOLUTION NO. 05-196

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation (the Constitution) Article VI, Section**
2 **1 (d)(2) vests the Tohono O'odham Council (Legislative Council) with the power to**
3 **manage any funds within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation and to**
4 **appropriate funds for the benefit of the Nation and its members; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Constitution, Article VI, Section 1 (d)(3) vests the Legislative Council with the**
6 **powers to adopt, approve and amend annual budgets and to authorize the**
7 **expenditure of funds in accordance with approved budgets; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council did approve Resolution No. 03-564 modifying the Gaming**
9 **Revenue Distribution Formula Authorized by Resolution No. 94-098; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council did approve Executive Branch, \$38,571,596.98 Resolution No.**
11 **04-609 and 04-702; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Enrollment Program is responsible for maintaining the Nation's records for**
13 **active membership files and historical archives for preservation of information**
14 **which the Nation's identity depends; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Enrollment Program is requesting to utilize Executive surplus funding for a**
16 **major capital purchase of a rotary file system to upgrade its current records**
17 **management system that would provide adequate space, protection and security of**
18 **the records maintained by the program.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
20 **approves and authorizes expenditure of the Executive revenue surplus funds from**
21 **the FY 2005 General Revenue for the Enrollment Program Amendment #1 budget in**
22 **the amount of \$40,000.00 for a one-time major capital purchase.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that this one-time funding**
24 **allocation and adjusted budget will revert to the Base Budget in FY 06.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH Day**
26 **of APRIL, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
27 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2)**
28 **& (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
29 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
30 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
31 **Stat. 984).**
