9		support of the Petition for Special Action filed in the Arizona Supreme Court (No. CV-
10		04-0385-SA); and
11	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Resolution 05-105, the Legislative Council approved the filing of the
12		amicus curiae brief; and
13	WHEREAS,	additional funding is required to compensate the Attorneys for the legal
14		representation provided in connection with the preparation of the amicus curiae
15		brief; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Attorney General has proposed Amendment No. 1 to the Attorney Contract which
17		increases the Contract amount from \$5,000 to \$10,000; and
18	WHEREAS,	the budget of the Office of Attorney General (01-1031-810) has sufficient funds for the
19		increased Contract amount; and
20	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs and Budget & Finance Committees recommend approval by the
21		Legislative Council of Amendment No. 1 to the Attorney Contract.

23		1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves Amendment No. 1 to the
24		Attorney Contract, in the form attached hereto, which increases the Contract
