(Setting May 16, 2005 Special Session for School Presentations)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 05-217


1 **WHEREAS, according to the Legislative Rules, Article I, Section 1.D.1., "The Legislative Council**
2 **may, by majority vote, call for a Special Session to be held for the purposes of**
3 **completing unfinished agenda, addressing issues requiring an Executive Session,**
4 **and/or reviewing special reports from Committees, Programs or other sources.";** and

5 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council Human Resources Development Committee has requested**
6 **that a special session be set for May 16, 2005 for school presentations from Ha:san**
7 **Preparatory and Leadership School, Indian Oasis School District and the Bureau of**
8 **Indian Affairs.**

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby sets a**
10 **special session for May 16, 2005 for school presentations from Ha:san Preparatory**
11 **and Leadership School, Indian Oasis School District and the Bureau of Indian Affairs.**

12 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 03RD, Day of**
13 **MAY, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,289.2 FOR; 107.70 AGAINST;**
14 **232.80 NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1**
15 **(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
16 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
17 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
18 **Stat. 984).**
