16	WHEREAS,	the San Lucy District Finance Manager identified funds consisting of Gaming							
17		Revenues in the amount of \$714,331.89, interest from P.L. 99-503 in the amount of							
18		\$948,131.11, and other revenues in the amount of \$309,658.03 for a total of							
19		\$1,972,121.03 to fund the FY 2005 San Lucy District budget; and
