

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the FY 2005 Budget Amendment for the Tohono O'odham Nation Wildland
Fire Management (Preparedness))

RESOLUTION NO. 05-227

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation/Department of Public Safety/Fire Department has taken**
2 **over Operations of the P.L. 93-638, Wildland Fire Management (Preparedness) from**
3 **the Bureau of Indian Affairs to operate the program indefinitely; and**

4 **WHEREAS, funding has been provided by BIA Wildland P.L. 93-638, and P.L. 106-291 for the**
5 **operation of the Wildland Fire Management (Preparedness); and will be utilized to**
6 **provide emergency services in the saving of lives, property, and protection of natural**
7 **resources and wildlife on the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Wildland Fire Management Division/Fire Department request approval to include**
9 **the FY 2004 carry forward funds of \$537,582.24 to the original FY 2005 Budget; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Wildland Fire Management Division/Fire Department request approval to include**
11 **the additional \$200,000 awarded by the National Interagency Fire Center.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has**
13 **reviewed and approved the attached FY 2005 Budget amendment for \$1,163,581.17**
14 **for P.L. 93-638 Wildland Fire Management Division.**

15 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
16 **proposed FY 2004 carry forward of identified savings \$537,582.24 of carryover amount**
17 **ending September 2004 and the additional \$200,000 awarded by the National**
18 **Interagency Fire Center as presented in the attached program FY 2005 budget**
19 **amendment and authorizes the program to expend these funds accordingly.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH Day**
21 **of MAY, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,069.6 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
22 **-0- NOT VOTING; and 560.1 [12] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
23 **1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
24 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
25 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
26 **Stat. 984).**
