## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Delegating to the Nation's Chairwoman Authority Over Tohono O'odham Farming Authority)

RESOLUTION NO. 05-233

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1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "provide for,
2		appoint, or provide for the appointment of, and prescribe the duties and powers of
3		committees, boards, officers and agents; to establish and regulate subordinate
4		organizations for business purposes" (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,
5		Article VI, Section 1(b)); and
6	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Farming Authority exists as a wholly-owned enterprise of the
7		Nation in accordance with its Second Restated Plan of Operation of the Tohono
8		O'odham Farming Authority (Resolution No. 99-060); and
9	WHEREAS,	in CY 2004, the Tohono O'odham Farming Authority suffered an operating loss of
10		approximately \$4.1 million; and
11	WHEREAS,	it is in the best interest of the Nation to temporarily vest the Chairwoman of the
12		Nation with the power to exercise overriding authority over the Farming Authority,
13		including the Management Board.
14	NOW, THE	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby
15		authorizes the Chairwoman of the Tohono O'odham Nation to immediately take the
16		following actions:
17		1. Upon the Chairwoman's written directive and in her sole discretion, secure
18		and/or take control of any assets, including all bank accounts, credit cards and
19		accounts, property and financial records and documents now under the control
20		of the Farming Authority.
21		2. To demand and obtain any Farming Authority documents, work papers, records
22		or information from employees, contractors, agents, external auditors, the
23		Management Board or any other person or entity.
24		3. Upon the Chairwoman's written directive and in her sole discretion, suspend and
25		assume the authorities and powers of the Management Board or any of its
26		directors, including Board officers.
27		4. Call Management Board meetings and require the attendance of Board
28		members, any Farming Authority employees (including all managers)
29		contractors or agents, and the Legislative Council Agricultural Committee.

1	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairwoman shall regularly report all action taken and
2	information received pursuant to this Resolution to the Legislative Council Budget
3	and Finance Committee and Agricultural Committee.
4	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that, to this extent the terms of this Resolution conflict with provisions
5	of the Second Restated Plan of Operation of the Tohono O'odham Farming Authority,
6	the conflicting provisions of the Plan shall be deemed to be superceded until this
7	Resolution is amended or repealed.
