

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appropriating \$150,000 from the FY 2005 Surplus Revenue of the Executive Branch
to the Future Boys & Girls Club of the Tohono O'odham Nation)

RESOLUTION NO. 05-311

1 **WHEREAS, over the past five years the Boys & Girls Club and Steering Committee has worked**
2 **diligently to create, establish and offer a quality preventive program for the Tohono**
3 **O'odham Nation's youth; and**

4 **WHEREAS, members were formally authorized as the Boys & Girls Club Steering Committee by**
5 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 01-452; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Chairwoman of the Tohono O'odham Nation has identified \$150,000 from the**
7 **Tohono O'odham Nation's FY 2005 General Revenue Surplus funding to be**
8 **appropriated to the Boys & Girls Club Steering Committee from the sum appropriated**
9 **to the Executive Branch; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Future Boys & Girls Club of the Tohono O'odham Nation has requested approval**
11 **from the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Committees, Human Resource**
12 **Development Committee, Commerce Committee and Budget & Finance, to receive**
13 **\$150,000 from the Tohono O'odham Nation to establish a Boys & Girls Club on the**
14 **Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is aware that the Club has obtained support**
16 **of Sells District through Resolution No. SD-48-99; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Future Boys & Girls Club of the Tohono O'odham Nation has entered a lease for**
18 **approximately 0.795 acres for 25 years in the Sells District and Sells Community**
19 **through Legislative Council Resolution No. 03-401; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's elected leaders are aware of the tremendous need to**
21 **improve services for O'odham youth and have by numerous measures supported the**
22 **Boys & Girls Clubs of America's programs which inspire, enable, and create an**
23 **atmosphere for full potential development; and**

24 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has identified the Boys & Girls Clubs of America as an**
25 **opportunity for program training and program development for Nation's employees.**

26 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council appropriates**
27 **a one-time funding of \$150,000 from the FY 2005 General Revenue Surplus funding**
28 **appropriated to the Executive Branch to assist in establishing the Nation's Future**
29 **Boys & Girls Club on the Tohono O'odham Nation which will further promote and**

1 enhance the growth of the O'odham youth by providing a safe, positive and enriching
2 community.

3 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that, in accordance with the requirements of Resolution No. 05-080, the**
4 **\$150,000 appropriated pursuant to this Resolution shall be expended in accordance**
5 **with the Boys and Girls Club of Sells Annual Budget for the period from February 1,**
6 **2005 to January 31, 2006, which is hereby approved, provided that any funds not**
7 **expended before October 1, 2005 shall be returned to the General Revenue Surplus**
8 **account unless carryover is approved by Legislative Council resolution.**

9 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH Day**
10 **of JUNE, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,178.45 FOR; 262.35**
11 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
12 **Section 1 (d)(2) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
13 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
14 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
15 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


