

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approve the Higher Education Services FY 2005 Budget Amendment #1
Account #10-1215 and Carryover Savings)

RESOLUTION NO. 05-317

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation through the Higher Education Services Program has**
2 **been successfully providing counseling and financial assistance to eligible Tohono**
3 **O'odham to attend Post Secondary Institutes; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Higher Education Services Program, through the Grants and Contracts Office, has**
5 **received the BIA's FY 2005 Allocation in the amount of \$674,449.00 which reflects a**
6 **decrease in the FY 2005 budget in the amount of \$27,176.00; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Higher Education Services Program has a savings from Fiscal Year 2004 in the**
8 **amount of \$167,338.92, which was identified by Grants and Contracts Office; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the FY 2005 Higher Education Services Program modification reflects reducing line**
10 **item 856 (Client Support) and increasing line items (Allowances and Stipends), 630**
11 **(Insurance) 662 (Mileage - GSA), 720 (Supplies - Office), 721 (Supplies - Other), 812**
12 **(Public Relations), and 892 (Non-Major Capitol Equipment) to cover cost for**
13 **continued services.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
15 **Higher Education Services Program Budget Amendment #1 reflecting the FY 2005**
16 **Final Allocation of \$674,449.00 and the FY 2004 savings in the amount of \$167,338.92,**
17 **with the total budget to \$849,550.03.**

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the FY 2004 Higher Education Services Program modification**
19 **includes new line items, 751 Lease/Rental in the amount of \$579.00, 662 Mileage - GSA**
20 **in the amount of \$825.00 and 892 Non-Major Capitol Equipment in the amount of**
21 **\$3,500.00.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Chairwoman is hereby authorized to**
23 **negotiate and execute the budget provided that any amendments affecting the**
24 **funding or funding levels of this budget shall be submitted for approval by the**
25 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH. Day**
27 **of JUNE, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
28 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of**
29 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
30 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
31 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
