

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2005 Education Administration Modification-Amendment No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 05-318

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Education Department oversees all educational**
2 **programs that provide educational services designed to meet members educational**
3 **needs; and**

4 **WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 04-609, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the FY**
5 **2005 Education Administration Budget in the amount of \$389,572.51; and**

6 **WHEREAS, Resolution No. 05-080 of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved Executive**
7 **Surplus Funding from General Revenue of which \$75,000.00 will be utilized to develop**
8 **and replicate materials related to O'odham him dag as specified in the budget**
9 **justification; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Education-Administration has submitted for review and**
11 **approval the proposed FY 2005 Budget Modification-Amendment No. 01, which**
12 **decreases line item number 610 -Salaries & Wages by \$41,350.00, decreases line item**
13 **number 620-Fringe Benefits by \$12,405.00; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Modification-Amendment No. 01 increases line item number 712-Gas, Oil &**
15 **Coolants by \$2,755.00, increases line item number 720-Supplies-Office by \$5,000.00,**
16 **increases line item number 721-Supplies-Other by \$40,000.00, increases line item**
17 **722-Program Supplies by \$18,000, increases line item 810-Professional Services by**
18 **\$25,000.00, creates a new line item number 812-Public Relations by \$18,000.00,**
19 **creates a new line item number 750-Capital Major Equipment by \$20,000.00.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does**
21 **hereby approve and authorizes the expenditure of the attached budget for the**
22 **Education Administration FY 2005 Budget Modification-Amendment No.1 to the base**
23 **budget of \$389,572.51 and add a one time supplement from the Executive Surplus**
24 **Funding of \$75,000.00, which would increase the total base budget to \$464,572.51.**

25 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a new 812-Public Relations line item and 750-Capital Major**
26 **Equipment line item is being added to the budget.**

27 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this one-time funding allocation and adjusted budget will revert**
28 **to the Base Budget in FY06.**

1 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Chairwoman is hereby authorized to
2 execute the budget provided that any amendments affecting the funding or funding
3 levels of this budget shall be submitted for approval by this Council.

4 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH Day
5 of JUNE, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,223.75 FOR; 783.1
6 AGAINST; 433.95 NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
7 Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
8 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
9 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
10 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
