

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing the Tohono O'odham Nation Delegation to the National Congress
of American Indians 2005 Mid-Year Conference)**

RESOLUTION NO. 05-329

1 **WHEREAS, the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI) will hold its 2005 Mid-Year**
2 **Conference in Green Bay, Wisconsin on June 12-15, 2005; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is a long time member in good standing with the**
4 **National Congress of American Indians; and**

5 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation to continue its membership**
6 **in the National Congress of American Indians; and**

7 **WHEREAS, according to Article III, Section B (b) of the By-Laws of National Congress of American**
8 **Indians, "each member tribe shall designate its official representative from**
9 **individuals eligible for voting membership in this organization and may designate**
10 **alternates"; and**

11 **WHEREAS, according to Article III, Section B (c)(2) of the By-Laws of National Congress of**
12 **American Indians, "tribal representatives must have a current year Tribal resolution**
13 **specifying the person as a delegate."**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
15 **authorizes the following members to attend and serve as the Tohono O'odham Nation**
16 **delegation to the National Congress of American Indians:**

26 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
27 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
