

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Family Violence Prevention and Services Grant from the U.S. Department of Human Services Administration for Children and Families – DHHS/ACF)

RESOLUTION NO. 05-335

- 1 WHEREAS, prevention of injuries is a health priority for the Tohono O'odham Nation; and
2 WHEREAS, domestic violence is a source of injuries for individuals and family members; and
3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Domestic Violence Coalition is working to raise awareness of
4 domestic violence and develop services for domestic violence victims and their
5 families; and
6 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation received a U. S. Department of Justice STOP Violence
7 Against Women Discretionary grant to plan and develop services for domestic violence
8 victims.
- 9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:
- 10 1. Accepts and approves to expend grant award number 2004-G991538 from
11 DHHS/ACF to provide Family Violence Prevention and Services from July 1, 2004
12 through September 30, 2006.
 - 13 2. Funds must be obligated by September 30, 2005 and liquidated by September 30,
14 2006. Request for extensions of the obligation or liquidation requirements will not
15 be honored.
 - 16 3. Authorizes the Chairwoman of the Nation to execute the grant and expend funds
17 per the attached budget in the amount of \$129,725 through September 30, 2005.
 - 18 4. The Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: Chairwoman, Vice-Chairman or any
19 designated official is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute this agreement.

20 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 9TH Day
21 of JUNE, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,273.4 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
22 -0- NOT VOTING; and 167.4 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section
23 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
24 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
25 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
26 Stat. 984).




