9		the Trustee to reimburse the Attorneys for all costs and fees expended under the
10		Attorney Contract, and (4) address other legal matters as may be assigned by the
11		Attorney General to the Attorneys within the scope of the Attorney Contract; and
12	WHEREAS,	there are sufficient funds available in the Initiative Legal Research Account (Account and available in the Initiative Legal Research Account (Account available available in the Initiative Legal Research Account (Account available available
13		No. 24-1809-810) to fund the Attorney Contract; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs and Investment Committees recommend the approval of the
15		Attorney Contract by the Legislative Council.

18		with the law firm of Yoder & Langford, P.C. for the period ending September 30,
19		2005 in the amount of \$10,000 and in substantially the form attached hereto.

21		Research Account (Account No. 24-1809-810).
