

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(General Support Services, FY 2005 Budget Amendment No. 1)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 05-356**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council by Resolution No. 264-89 adopted the Policy**  
2 **Regarding Alcohol and Drugs; and**

3 **WHEREAS, funding from the Legislative Council Resolution No. 05-080 (Approving FY-2005**  
4 **General Revenue Surplus Funding and Authorizing a Divided Percentage Allocation**  
5 **to the Legislative, Judicial and Executive Branch) provides executive surplus funds**  
6 **for an initial tri-branch employee alcohol and drug testing program (\$24,500), and**  
7 **the purchase of a copier (\$12,000) for a total of \$36,500; and**

8 **WHEREAS, \$36,500 in non-recurring funding will be allocated to the Human Resources budget**  
9 **for FY-2005 for initial alcohol and drug testing program and to purchase capital**  
10 **equipment utilizing the Executive surplus funds; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Office has identified in its operational dollars to supplement**  
12 **the surplus amount for purchase of a copier; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Office has identified the need to create a new position for**  
14 **Training Specialist and identified funds by freezing one vacancy and utilizing funds**  
15 **from 612.5 Other Compensation line item; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the General Support Services, Human Resources Office, FY-2005 Budget Amendment**  
17 **No. 1 has been reviewed and approved by the Office of the Chairwoman, the Human**  
18 **Resources Development and Budget & Finance Committees.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that it**  
20 **hereby approves and authorizes the expenditure of one-time funding to be allocated**  
21 **for the General Support Services, Human Resources, Budget Amendment No. 1, for**  
22 **an initial tri-branch employee alcohol and drug testing program (\$24,500), and the**  
23 **purchase of a copier (\$12,000) for a total of \$36,500.**


24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby approves and**  
25 **authorizes the added line item of 750 Major Capital.**

26 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby approves and**  
27 **authorizes the General Support Services, Human Resources, FY-2005 Budget**  
28 **Amendment No. 1 to fund the new position of Training Specialist as amended.**

1 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that this one-time funding  
2 allocation and adjusted budget will revert to the Base Budget in FY-2006.

3 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 27<sup>TH</sup>. Day  
4 of JUNE, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0- AGAINST;  
5 -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2)  
6 & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
7 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
8 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
9 Stat. 984).




