

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving FY 2005 Budget Amendment/Budget Modification to Tribal Base Budget and**  
**Transfer of Funds - Law Enforcement Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department)**

RESOLUTION NO. 05-357

1 **WHEREAS, for fiscal year 2005 the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department was appropriated**  
2 **funds to address various needs of the community and the Police Department's**  
3 **programs; and**

4 **WHEREAS, due to the need to reflect the actual costs for inmates' expenses under the corrections**  
5 **programs for future funding purposes, statistics; and**

6 **WHEREAS, there is no line item in the current FY 2005, Tohono O'odham Nation Police**  
7 **Department budget for program supplies to be used for inmate supplies, hygiene**  
8 **items, hobbies, crafts; and**


9 **WHEREAS, in order to purchase such equipment and supplies, a new line must be established as**  
10 **the Program Supplies Account 01-1090-722 and a transfer of \$35,000 from other line**  
11 **items is necessary.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that it**  
13 **hereby approves the establishment of a new line item account number 01-1090-722**  
14 **Program Supplies to the FY 2005 Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department Tribal**  
15 **Base Budget.**

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$35,000 be transferred from other lines items to 01-1090-722**  
17 **Program Supplies Account line item to be expended accordingly.**

18 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 27<sup>TH</sup>. Day**  
19 **of JUNE, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
20 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2)**  
21 **& (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
22 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
23 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
24 **Stat. 984).**
