

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the CDC Effective Strategies to Reduce Motor Vehicle Injuries Among
American Indians and Alaska Natives Cooperative Agreement Budget Modification)**

RESOLUTION NO. 05-364

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been administering a CDC Effective Strategies to**
2 **Reduce Motor Vehicle Injuries Among American Indians and Alaska Natives**
3 **Cooperative Agreement; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the changes in line items are needed in order to better fulfill the scope of work for**
5 **the first year; and**

6 **WHEREAS, a total of \$8,725 will be moved from Professional Services to Other Compensation to**
7 **cover the projected cost of overtime pay for TOPD officers; and**

8 **WHEREAS, a total of \$7,991.73 in savings is projected for the Consultant line item due to a delay**
9 **in contracting with an evaluation partner and \$420.34 in savings is projected for the**
10 **Public Relations line item; and**

11 **WHEREAS, this savings will be transferred to increase Fringe Benefits by \$2,617.50 and Travel**
12 **by \$2,000; and**

13 **WHEREAS, this savings will also be transferred to create line items for Program Supplies \$2,000**
14 **and Food \$1,000; and**

15 **WHEREAS, all other line items will remain the same.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 17 **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves the budget**
18 **modification as outlined, which maintains the original budget total of \$71,634.**
19 **2. The Tohono O'odham Nation officials, to wit: the Chairwoman and Vice**
20 **Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and**
21 **execute the Inter Governmental Agreement and expend funds.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 27TH Day**
23 **of JUNE, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
24 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of**
25 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
26 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
27 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
