

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Road Priorities FY 2005 Thru FY 2010)**

RESOLUTION NO. 05-365

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation (The "Nation") is a Federally recognized Indian Tribe**
2 **and the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council (the "Legislative Council") is the**
3 **governing body of the Nation; and**

4 **WHEREAS, there is a need to construct new public roads and improve existing public roads**
5 **within the Nation to promote the health, safety and welfare of the public and**
6 **stimulate economic development; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Nation's Planning Department held public meetings in each of the Nation's eleven**
8 **(11) Districts for the purpose of identifying and prioritizing needed road**
9 **construction/improvement projects for inclusion in the Tohono O'odham Nation**
10 **Transportation Improvement Plan; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Governing Councils of each of the 11 Districts have identified and prioritized road**
12 **construction/improvement projects and have requested, by District Council**
13 **Resolution, that they be submitted include in the Tohono O'odham Nations**
14 **Transportation Improvement Plan; and**

15 **WHEREAS, some of the public roads identified in the District road construction/improvement**
16 **priorities are not currently in the Indian Reservation Road (IRR) inventory and need**
17 **to be added to the inventory; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Natural Resources Committee has reviewed the**
19 **construction/improvement project priorities submitted by the Districts and**
20 **recommends Tohono O'odham Nation Priority List (Attachment "A"), made up of**
21 **projects from each District, for Legislative Council Approval.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council has reviewed the Tohono**
23 **O'odham Nation Priority List (Attachment "A") recommended by the Natural Resource**
24 **Committee and hereby approves and adopts the priorities listed in this attachment.**


25 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council requests that eligible roads identified in**
26 **Attachment "A", which are not currently listed in the IRR inventory, be added to the**
27 **inventory as BIA roads, and hereby consents to granting a right-of-way to the BIA for**
28 **the construction and maintenance of these roads, pursuant to the submission and**
29 **approval of the appropriate right-of-way documents.**

1 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairperson or their designee is authorized to forward this**
2 **Resolution and the attached Priority List to the BIA, Western Regional Office, Division**
3 **of Transportation for the purpose of acquiring and programming annual TON road**
4 **construction funds.**

5 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Chairperson or their designee is authorized to execute**
6 **whatever documents are necessary to fulfill the intent of this resolution.**

7 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 27TH Day**
8 **of JUNE, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
9 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (j) of**
10 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono 'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
11 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
12 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**






