

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Arizona Division of Emergency Management Assistant Grant)

RESOLUTION NO. 05-378

1 **WHEREAS, the Arizona Division of Emergency Management Assistant Grant has distributed grants**
2 **to counties, to fund for emergency operations planning and to enhance the terrorism**
3 **annex that provides public safety services within their respective jurisdictions; and**

4 **WHEREAS, Indian tribes have been designated to receive supplemental funds through the**
5 **counties, requiring tribes to enter into Intergovernmental Agreements with counties;**
6 **and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has negotiated an Intergovernmental Agreement with**
8 **Pima County for \$10,000.00 on a reimbursement basis to finance for emergency**
9 **operations by the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Public Safety to review and**
10 **update their emergency operation plan designated by the Intergovernmental**
11 **Agreement; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Supplemental funding for emergency operations authorized each jurisdiction to**
13 **review and update their emergency operations plan, develop or enhance a terrorism**
14 **annex and make the plan compatible and interoperate with the Pima County**
15 **Emergency Plan; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Agreement has been reviewed and approved by the Tohono O'odham Nation**
17 **Legislative Council; and the original EMA Grant program ended December 15, 2004;**
18 **and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been offered by the Grantee an extension for the**
20 **period of performance to end December 15, 2005; and**

21 **WHEREAS, the request to approve the EMA Grant extension has been reviewed by the appropriate**
22 **committees.**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
24 **extension and authorizes carryover of the unencumbered funds of above-mentioned**
25 **Intergovernmental Agreement with Pima County for \$10,000.00 on a reimbursement**
26 **basis for the emergency operations planning under the Emergency Management**
27 **Assistant Grant and approves a Waiver of Indirect Cost to administer this grant.**

28 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Public Safety**
29 **is authorized to expend carryover-unencumbered funds from this grant in the amount**
30 **of \$10,000.00 beginning December 15, 2004 through December 15, 2005.**
