

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY2005 Natural Resources Administration Budget (01-5015) Modification 2
and Amendment 2 to increase and decrease line items and add the Major Capital
Equipment line item to FY2005 budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 05-389

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the FY 2005 Natural Resources
2 Administration Budget with Council Resolution No. 04-609; and
3 WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the addition or the deletion of line items to the budget
4 shall be submitted for review and approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
5 Council; and
6 WHEREAS, line items to be increased are 630 Insurance \$283.00, 712 Gas, oil & coolants
7 \$1,717.00, 721 Supplies-other \$6,500.00 and 771 RM Vehicles \$4,448.93 line items to
8 be decreased are 610 Salaries \$34,305.28, Fringe Benefits \$10,291.62; and
9 WHEREAS, line item 750 Major Capital Equipment will be added to the Natural Resource
10 Administration budget.
11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it
12 hereby approves and authorizes the Natural Resources Administration FY2005
13 Budget Modification 2 and Amendment 2 to allocate Savings from line items 610
14 Salaries and 620 Fringe Benefits in the amount of \$31,647.97 into item 750 Major
15 Capital Equipment.

16 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12TH Day
17 of JULY, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
18 -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of
19 Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham
20 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
21 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


