

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appointing Nation's Intertribal Monitoring Association on Indian Trust Funds
Representative and Alternate)**

RESOLUTION NO. 05-394

- 1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power “[t]o consult, negotiate and conclude**
2 **agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O’odham Nation with Federal,**
3 **State and local governments and other Indian tribes . . . or with private persons or**
4 **organizations on all matters within the authority of the Tohono O’odham Council”**
5 **(Constitution of the Tohono O’odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and**
- 6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O’odham Nation is a charter member of the Intertribal Monitoring**
7 **Association on Indian Trust Funds (“ITMA”); and**
- 8 **WHEREAS, the ITMA is dedicated to monitoring, reviewing, and analyzing all measures of Indian**
9 **trust fund and asset-related activities of the federal government; and**
- 10 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tohono O’odham Nation to continue its participation**
11 **in the ITMA and its consultations with ITMA member tribes in order to hold the**
12 **federal government accountable for its many decades of Indian trust asset**
13 **mismanagement; and**
- 14 **WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee, which has been delegated authority to**
15 **recommend legislative measures concerning the use of funds held in trust by the**
16 **federal government, has recommended the appointment of Councilman Gerald**
17 **Fayuant as the Nation’s ITMA representative (Plan of Operation for Budget and**
18 **Finance Committee, Article I(b)(3) (1988)); and**
- 19 **WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has further recommended the appointment of**
20 **Councilwoman Delma Garcia as the Nation’s ITMA alternate.**
- 21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council hereby**
22 **appoints Councilman Gerald Fayuant as the Nation’s Intertribal Monitoring**
23 **Association on Indian Trust Funds representative.**
- 24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council hereby appoints**
25 **Councilwoman Delma Garcia as the Nation’s Intertribal Monitoring Association on**
26 **Indian Trust Funds alternate.**

1 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that these appointments shall supercede any prior ITMA
2 **representative and alternate appointments.**

3 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the appointment made pursuant to this Resolution shall expire if
4 **the appointee vacates his or her elected office for any reason.**

5 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH. Day**
6 **of JULY, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.8 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
7 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [-0-] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of**
8 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
9 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
10 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
