

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving the Arizona Department of Health Services Preparedness and Response**  
**for Bio-Terrorism Grant)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 05-396**

1 **WHEREAS, Pima County was awarded the Preparedness and Response for Bio-Terrorism Grant,**  
2 **through the Arizona Department of Health Services; and the Tohono O'odham**  
3 **Nation on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation Fire Department is qualified and is**  
4 **willing to participate in the Bio-Terrorism Preparedness Program to train**  
5 **Emergency Medical Technician personnel to administer prophylactic medication**  
6 **and/or immunizations in case of a Bio-Terrorism emergency; and**

7 **WHEREAS, Tohono O'odham Nation would receive funds through the Arizona Department of**  
8 **Health Services; and Pima County is requiring that the Tohono O'odham Nation**  
9 **enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Pima County Health Department**  
10 **for a joint and/or cooperative action to develop and enhance the State of Arizona,**  
11 **Public Health Preparedness and Response for Bio-Terrorism in Pima County and the**  
12 **Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has negotiated an Intergovernmental Agreement with**  
14 **Pima County for \$8,000.00 to train Emergency Medical Technician Personnel to**  
15 **administer prophylactic medications and/or immunizations in case of a Bio-**  
16 **Terrorism emergency and requests a Waiver of Indirect Costs associated with**  
17 **administering this grant; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the authorized category is 610.5 Other Compensation for Emergency Medical**  
19 **Technician Personnel to attend training courses to administer prophylactic**  
20 **medications and/or immunizations in case of a Bio-Terrorism emergency; and**

21 **WHEREAS, the Agreement has been reviewed and approved by the Office of the Attorney**  
22 **General, Executive Committee, Domestic Affairs Committee, Budget & Finance**  
23 **Committee, and said committees recommend approval by the Legislative Council.**

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
25 **above-mentioned Intergovernmental Agreement with Pima County under the**  
26 **Arizona Department of Health Services for \$8,000.00 under the category 610.5 Other**

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1                    **Compensation for Emergency Medical Technician Personnel to train for a Bio-**  
2                    **Terrorism emergency, approves a Waiver of Indirect Costs to administer this grant.**

3 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Fire Department is authorized to**  
4                    **accept and expend funds from this grant in the amount of \$8,000.00 on a**  
5                    **reimbursement basis as outlined within the above-mentioned Intergovernmental**  
6                    **Agreement (as attached).**

7 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
8 **of JULY, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.8 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
9 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of**  
10 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**  
11 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
12 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
