

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving the Solid Waste Management Program FY05 Budget Amendment 1 (01-1097))**

**RESOLUTION NO. 05-406**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council adopted the Solid Waste Management Code**  
2 **and Solid Waste Management Plan on February 12, 1997 with Resolution No. 97-041,**  
3 **which in part created the Solid Waste Management Program (SWMP); and**

4 **WHEREAS, the SWMP has expanded its scope of work since its inception in 1997 to include junk**  
5 **vehicle removal, contractor waste removal, community bulky waste collection and**  
6 **disposal, illegal migrant waste clean-up, household hazardous waste collection and**  
7 **disposal, dirt and gravel hauling, dangerous and unwanted building demolition,**  
8 **water hauling, emergency response and special requests from time to time; and**

9 **WHEREAS, to accomplish this expanded scope of work SWMP has hired additional staff; and**  
10 **apply for and receive additional grants; and worked to increase the total amount of**  
11 **collected fees for services; and**

12 **WHEREAS, for SWMP to be successful, it needs to attract and retain experienced and talented**  
13 **supervisory staff; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the SWMP proposes, with the support from the Human Resources Office, the**  
15 **reclassification of the Crew Foreman position to Solid Waste Supervisor, the**  
16 **Administrative Assistant position to Assistant Manager and the Manager position to**  
17 **Administrator.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**  
19 **approves the SWMP FY05 Budget Amendment 1 for the reclassification of three**  
20 **positions; Crew Foreman to Solid Waste Supervisor, Administrative Assistant to**  
21 **Assistant Manager and Manager to Administrator, as per attached Budget.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation's officials to wit: the Chairwoman and**  
23 **any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the Budget,**  
24 **provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding of this Budget shall**  
25 **be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14<sup>TH</sup> Day of JULY, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,798.2 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 642.6 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d) (3) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
