

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
**(Approving the Tohono O'odham TERO Commission FY-2005 Budget Modification/
Amendment No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 05-412

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council (formerly known as the Papago Council)
2 enacted Tribal Employment Rights Ordinance No. 01-85; and

3 WHEREAS, the continued operation of the Tribal Employment Rights Office is essential to
4 increase employment of Indians and eradicate employment discrimination within the
5 exterior boundaries of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

6 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham TERO Commission formulates, adopts, amends and rescinds
7 rules regulations and guidelines reasonably necessary to carry out the provisions of
8 the Ordinance; and

9 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham TERO Commission is a member of the Southwest TERO Region;
10 and

11 WHEREAS, the Southwest TERO Region will host the 2005 National TERO Conference; and

12 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham TERO Commission supports the 2005 National TERO Conference;
13 and

14 WHEREAS, Line Item 812 - Public Relations will be added to the Tohono O'odham TERO
15 Commission Fiscal Year 2005 Budget to contribute to the 2005 National TERO
16 Conference; and

17 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham TERO Commission Fiscal Year 2005 Budget Amendment No. 1 has
18 been approved by the Office of the Chairwoman.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby
20 approve the Tohono O'odham TERO Commission Fiscal Year 2005 Budget
21 Modification/Amendment No. 1 which adds Line Item 812 - Public Relations.

22 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 18TH. Day
23 of JULY, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0- AGAINST;
24 -0- NOT VOTING; and [-0-] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of
25 Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham
26 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
27 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




