

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appointing Shawn Ramon to the TERO Commission for a Term Expiring December 31, 2007)

RESOLUTION NO. 05-456

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "provide for,**
2 **appoint, or provide for the appointment of, and prescribe the duties and powers of**
3 **committees, boards, officers and agents" (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**
4 **Article VI, Section 1(b)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, in 1985 the Papago Council enacted the Papago Employment Rights Ordinance ("TERO**
6 **Ordinance"), thereby establishing the Papago Employment Rights Commission (a.k.a.,**
7 **"TERO Commission") and vesting the Council with the power to select and appoint**
8 **TERO commissioners (TERO Ordinance, Ordinance No. 01-85, Section 6(B)(2)); and**

9 **WHEREAS, Section 6(C) of the TERO Ordinance further provides that "Commissioners shall be**
10 **appointed for terms of three years, or until their successors are appointed and**
11 **qualified, provided, however, that appointments to the Commission shall be made in**
12 **such a way and for such terms that their terms shall be staggered so that the terms of**
13 **office of only two Commissioners will end in any single year."; and**

14 **WHEREAS, Shawn Carlos was appointed to the Commission with a term ending December 31, 2004**
15 **and he continues to serve until his successor is appointed and qualified (Resolution**
16 **No. 04-048); and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee has been delegated authority to "review and**
18 **recommend action by the Legislative Council on appointments of . . . TERO**
19 **Commissioners" (Plan of Operation for the Domestic Affairs Committee, Article III.D.**
20 **as adopted by Legislative Order No. 01-431); and**

21 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee has interviewed qualified TERO Commission**
22 **applicants one of whom, when appointed will serve a term commencing on the**
23 **effective date of this resolution and ending December 31, 2007 or until his successor**
24 **is appointed and qualified.**

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby appoints**
26 **Shawn Ramon to the TERO Commission commencing upon the effective date of this**
27 **Resolution and ending December 31, 2007 or until his successor is appointed and**
28 **qualified.**
