WHEREAS,	Article V, Section 4 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the
	Tohono O'odham Council with the power to delegate authority to the Council
	Chairperson and Vice Chairperson; and
WHEREAS,	on September 13, 2001, the Legislative Council adopted Legislative Order No. 01-447,
	"Approving Delegation of Authority to Legislative Council Chairperson and Vice
	Chairperson"; and
WHEREAS,	pursuant to Legislative Order No. 01-447, the Legislative Officers are delegated
	authority to "[a]llocate funds, staff, and other resources for the effective operation of
	the Legislative Branch" and to "[a]pprove Legislative Branch expenditures"; and
WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council and Branch staff are often required to travel off the Nation
	and outside the State of Arizona to participate in national-level meetings, coordinate
	with other tribal officials, and to work with elected and appointed federal officials on
	behalf of the Tohono O'odham; and
WHEREAS,	such travel requires the allocation of vehicles, staff time, and other resources as well
	as the expenditure of limited funds; and
WHEREAS,	such travel should be authorized and funded in a manner which holds travelers
	accountable and serves the Tohono O'odham, but that does not prevent the Council
	committees from accomplishing their work or achieving quorums; and
WHEREAS,	in an effort to address concerns over the amount and necessity of Legislative Branch
	travel, the Legislative Council previously adopted the "Revised Legislative Branch
	Travel Policy" (Legislative Order No. 02-482); and
WHEREAS,	it is in the best interest of the Legislative Branch and the members of the Tohono
	O'odham Nation that the existing travel policy be updated and revised; and
WHEREAS,	the Legislative Officers have developed the attached, amended "Legislative Branch
	Travel Policy," which is incorporated by this reference, to further improve fiscal
	accountability and clarify the travel authorization process.
