

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Setting September 26 and September 27, 2005 Special Session to Address FY 2006 Budgets)**

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 05-482**

1 **WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation empowers**  
2 **the Legislative Council "[T]o establish rules and procedures to regulate all meetings**  
3 **of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing committees, boards, and special**  
4 **committees"; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee and the Executive Office have been reviewing the**  
6 **FY 2006 budgets; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee requests that a special session be held on**  
8 **September 26 and 27, 2005 to address FY 2006 Budgets.**

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**  
10 **schedules a Special Session for September 26 and September 27, 2005 to address FY**  
11 **2006 Budgets.**

12 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12<sup>TH</sup> Day of**  
13 **SEPTEMBER 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,357.1 FOR; 83.70**  
14 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
15 **Section 1(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
16 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
17 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
18 **Stat. 984).**
