

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Supporting the Honey Bee Village Archaeological Preserve Conceptual Plan**  
**Proposed by the Town of Oro Valley, Arizona)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 05-497**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham and their ancestors, the Hohokam have inhabited Southern**  
2 **Arizona since time immemorial; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the need to protect, preserve, and manage**  
4 **cultural resources on its traditional-use lands; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation supported the Pima County Historic Preservation Bond**  
6 **Project (Resolution 03-501) that was passed by Pima County Voters in 2004; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes that the Pima County Bond issue passed by**  
8 **voters in 2004 allocated funds for the preservation of the Honey Bee Village, a**  
9 **prehistoric Hohokam village site located in Oro Valley, Arizona; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation (Executive staff, Legislative Cultural Preservation**  
11 **Committee members and Cultural Affairs staff) have worked closely with the Town of**  
12 **Oro Valley, the Pima County Historic Preservation Office, the Arizona State Museum**  
13 **and Desert Archaeology in the past year to develop the Honey Bee Village**  
14 **Archaeological Preserve Conceptual Plan (see attached summary) that focuses on the**  
15 **protection and preservation of the core area (13 acres) of the site as a Pima County**  
16 **Park and that funds from the Pima County Bond Issue passed by voters in 2004 will**  
17 **be utilized to identify other significant and culturally sensitive areas of the site for**  
18 **preservation and protection.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**  
20 **support the Honey Bee Village Archaeological Preserve Conceptual Plan and looks**  
21 **forward to working with the Town of Oro Valley and the Pima County Historic**  
22 **Preservation Office to implement this plan in the coming years.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14<sup>TH</sup>, Day**  
24 **of SEPTEMBER, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-**  
25 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
26 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
27 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
28 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
29 **Stat. 984).**
