

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appointing the IHS Tucson Area Tribal Leaders Diabetes Committee Alternate)**

RESOLUTION NO. 05-501

1 **WHEREAS, the Tribal Leaders Diabetes Committee ("TLDC") is a non-profit organization**
2 **representing federally recognized tribes in the United States in advocating for the**
3 **improvement of diabetes care and prevention among American Indians; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the TLDC was created by the director of the Indian Health Service ("IHS") as an**
5 **advisory committee in matters related to the Special Diabetes Programs for Indians**
6 **("SDPI"); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the TLDC representatives and alternates represent each of the twelve IHS Areas and**
8 **are generally tribal officials appointed by the tribal governments within each service**
9 **area; and**

10 **WHEREAS, since 1997 representatives of the Tohono O'odham Nation have served on the TLDC**
11 **from the Tucson Area ("TLDC Area Representative"); and**

12 **WHEREAS, historically, members of the Legislative Council Health and Human Services**
13 **Committee have been appointed to serve as the TLDC Area Representative and**
14 **Alternate; and**

15 **WHEREAS former Councilman Dennis Ramon served as alternate to the TLDC until his**
16 **resignation from Legislative Council; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee has recommended that Councilwoman**
18 **Wavalene Saunders be appointed to replace Dennis Ramon as the TLDC Area**
19 **Alternate.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does**
21 **hereby:**

- 22 1. **Appoint Councilwoman Wavalene Saunders as the TLDC Area Alternate**
23 **Representative.**
24 2. **Request that IHS Director Dr. Charles Grim, the current TLDC Co-Chairs, and the**
25 **TLDC recognize Councilwoman Wavalene Saunders as the TLDC Alternate**
26 **Representative.**

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the appointment made pursuant to this Resolution shall**
28 **immediately expire if Councilwoman Saunders vacates her office as a Legislative**
29 **Council representative for any reason.**


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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15TH Day of SEPTEMBER, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(c)(2) and 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


