

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Authorizing the Tohono O'odham Nation Delegation to the National Congress**  
**of American Indians 2005 Annual Session)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 05-518**

1 **WHEREAS, the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI) will hold its 2005 Annual Session**  
2 **in Tulsa, Oklahoma on October 30 - November 4, 2005; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is a long time member in good standing with the**  
4 **National Congress of American Indians; and**

5 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation to continue its membership**  
6 **in the National Congress of American Indians; and**

7 **WHEREAS, according to the By-Laws of National Congress of American Indians ("By-Laws"), each**  
8 **member tribe shall designate its official representative from individuals eligible for**  
9 **voting membership and may also designate alternates; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the By-Laws further provide that each tribal representative must have a current**  
11 **tribal resolution specifying the person to serve as that tribe's delegate.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**  
13 **authorizes the following officials to attend and serve as the Tohono O'odham Nation's**  
14 **delegation to the National Congress of American Indians 2005 Annual Session:**

16 **Legislative Council Vice-Chairman Verlon Jose, Voting Alternate**

17 **Tohono O'odham Vice-Chairman Ned Norris, Jr.**

19 **Councilman Timothy Joaquin**

20 **Councilwoman Felicia Nunez**

21 **Councilwoman Frances Miguel**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 16<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
23 **of SEPTEMBER, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-**  
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
25 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
26 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
27 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
28 **Stat. 984).**


