

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approval of the FY 2006 Department of Health and Human Services/  
Indian Health Service Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 05-529

1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has historically contracted certain functions from the  
2 Indian Health Service; and

3 WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service Annual Funding Agreement for FY 2006 has been approved  
4 by the Legislative Council in the September general session; and

5 WHEREAS, the Executive Branch has approved and presented the following budgets as attached  
6 and incorporated by this reference, to be effective October 1, 2005 through September  
7 30, 2006 and requests authorization to expend the funds listed below;

12 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham  
13 Nation's Official, to wit: The Chairwoman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official  
14 are authorized to negotiate and execute the contract, provided however, that any  
15 amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for  
16 further prior approval.

17 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 26<sup>TH</sup> Day  
18 of SEPTEMBER, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,975.4 FOR; 210.50  
19 AGAINST; 254.9 NOT VOTING; and [-0-] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
20 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the  
21 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
22 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
23 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




