1	WHEREAS, the Tonono O'odham Nation is currently operating the Tohono O'odham Veterans
2	Affairs Office through a Tribal subsidy; and
3	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Veterans Affairs has provided service to all veterans; and
4	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has received \$50,000.00 from United States Department
5	of Housing and Urban Development to be utilized for expense to build a Veterans
6	Memorial Monument and Park within the Tohono O'odham Nation; and
7	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Veterans Affairs has prepared the FY 2006 Veterans Affairs Office
8	Memorial Park budget to use the funds to cover expense.
9	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby
10	accepts the FY 2006 Tohono O'odham Nation-Veterans Affairs Office Memorial Park
11	Budget at \$50,000.00 to cover expense; The program is authorized to expend funds
12	upon approval of the grant award.
13	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Veterans Memorial Monument and Park budget is designated
14	as a multi-year Capital Project.
15	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
16	Nation's Official, to wit: the Chairwoman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official
17	are authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any
18	amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for
19	further prior approval.
