

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY-06 Budget for Youth Transportation Art Grant)

RESOLUTION NO. 05-536

1 WHEREAS, the Planning Department's Transportation Program applied for and received grant
2 funding in the amount of \$50,000.00; and

3 WHEREAS, this project is funded by a Pima Association of Governments grant to enhance
4 community pride by involving District youth in designing public transportation art;
5 and

6 WHEREAS, the Planning Department is requesting approval of the FY-96 Budget of remaining
7 funds in the amount of \$49,325.70; and

8 WHEREAS, the grant will be administered by the Planning Department's Transportation
9 Program.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
11 accepts the budget amount of \$49,325.70 and approves the attached budget in the
12 amount of \$49,325.70.

13 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, to wit: the Chairwoman,
14 Vice-Chairman and any designated official are authorized to negotiate and execute
15 the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funds or funding
16 levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval.

17 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Youth Transportation Art Grant is authorized to expend the
18 funds in the amount of \$49,325.70 beginning October 1, 2005.

19 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 26TH. Day
20 of SEPTEMBER, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-
21 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [-0-] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
22 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
23 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
24 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
25 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


