

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval to Accept and Expend U.S. Bureau of Land Management Grant Award
of \$59,000 for the Undocumented Migrant (UDM) Waste Clean-up Project)**

RESOLUTION NO. 05-551

1 **WHEREAS, Article XVIII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation sets out the Council's**
2 **continuing responsibility to assure for all members safe and healthful surroundings;**

3 **and**

4 **WHEREAS, the lands of the Tohono O'odham Nation have been severely impacted by the large**
5 **amount of waste left by Undocumented Migrants as they pass through the Nation's**
6 **lands; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management Program (SWMP) is tasked with the removal of solid**
8 **waste from the Nation's lands; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Bureau of Land Management has allocated \$59,000 to enable the SWMP to clean-up**
10 **solid waste left behind by undocumented migrants.**


11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
12 **the acceptance of \$59,000 from the US Bureau of Land Management for the**
13 **Undocumented Migrant (UDM) Waste Clean-up Project.**

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that the Tohono**
15 **O'odham Nation's Official, to wit: the Chairwoman, Vice Chairman and any designated**
16 **person are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however,**
17 **that any amendments affecting the funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for**
18 **further prior approval.**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Solid Waste Management Program is authorized to expend**
20 **funds from this grant as detailed in the attached budget.**

21 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 27TH Day**
22 **of SEPTEMBER, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-**
23 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [-0-] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
24 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
25 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
26 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
27 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




