

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Authorization to expend the Environmental Protection Agency Clean Water Act 106  
grant allocation for the Water Resources Study Program FY2006 budget 11-5017)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 05-553**

1 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program was awarded an Environmental Protection**  
2 **Agency (EPA) Clean Water Act 106 grant for water quality planning and management**  
3 **in the amount of \$160,000.00; and**

4 **WHEREAS, this grant requires a 5.26% matching amount of \$8,422.00, which will be met through**  
5 **in-kind services provided by the Water Resources Study Program; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program budget 11-5017 has been reviewed by the Tohono**  
7 **O'odham Legislative Water Resources Committee and Budget and Finance Committee**  
8 **and has been recommended to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council for approval.**

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the**  
10 **expenditure of the EPA Clean Water Act 106 grant, in the amount of \$160,000, for the**  
11 **Water Resources Study Program FY 2006 budget 11-5017, in accordance with the**  
12 **budget attached hereto.**

13 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
14 **Nation's Official, to wit: the Chairwoman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official**  
15 **are authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any**  
16 **amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for**  
17 **further prior approval.**

18 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 27<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
19 **of SEPTEMBER, 2005 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,440.80 FOR; -0-**  
20 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [-0-] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
21 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
22 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
23 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
24 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


