11	Water Resources Study Program FY 2006 budget 11-5017, in accordance with the
12	budget attached hereto.
13	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
14	Nation's Official, to wit: the Chairwoman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official
15	are authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any
16	amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for
17	further prior approval.
